Please choose **1** of the following options:

1. Write a Newspaper Report

Imagine you are a journalist in 1939, the year Sutton Hoo was discovered.

- Write a newspaper article announcing the discovery.
- Include quotes from archaeologists, descriptions of the items, and why it's an exciting find.

2. Create a Model of an Artefact

Choose one object found at Sutton Hoo (e.g., the helmet, shield, or a piece of jewellery).

- Make a 3D model using cardboard, foil, clay, or any creative materials.
- Label it and explain what it was used for and what it tells us about Anglo-Saxon life.

3. Design a Museum Display Board

Pretend you are designing an information board for a museum exhibit about Sutton Hoo.

- Include key facts, drawings or printed images, and short captions explaining the finds.
- Your board should teach visitors what Sutton Hoo was and why it matters.
