

## Summer 2 Homework Project

For this half term's homework project, I am inviting both Year 5 and Year 6 pupils to take part in a special **Role Model Research Project**. This links beautifully to our work on resilience, aspiration and preparing our older pupils for the transition to secondary school or their last year at primary.

Children may choose **one** of the following three options:

1. **Inspiring Person Biography** Your child chooses a role model they admire – this could be an athlete, scientist, author, activist, historical figure, or even a family member. They create a short biography explaining who the person is, what challenges they faced, and what makes them inspiring.
2. **Role Model Poster** A creative poster celebrating their chosen role model. This should include key facts, achievements, and three qualities your child would like to develop themselves.
3. **Interview-Style Report** Children imagine they are interviewing their role model. They write a set of thoughtful questions and create the answers their role model might give, focusing on perseverance, success and overcoming challenges.

These tasks are designed to encourage independence, confidence, and self-reflection – all important skills as pupils move through upper Key Stage 2 and prepare for the next stage of their education.

Please note that this homework is in addition to TTRS, reading and spelling practice.

This project needs to be handed in before Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July please.
